21/P/012 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

a) 21/02102/FUL Shropshire Fencing Supplies Ltd, Old Station Yard, Hadnall. Proposal: Erection of one 11.24 metre high cylindroconic bulk cement silo on a concrete base.

A site visit had been held 4th June 2021, attended by the applicants and ClIrs BB, AB, ND, and SP.

The committee decided unanimously to **support** the application for the following reasons:

- The proposed location of the silo is tucked back beside the north face of the factory shed adjacent to the mixing shed and screened from the north and east by trees (deciduous). The height of the proposed silo would be approximately 1.5 metres more than the height of the existing structure, a working factory unit.
- The silo would remove the need to feed individual bags of cement into the mixing drum, thereby eliminating the current practice of cutting open bags and releasing cement dust; the need to dispose of the bags; and the associated manual handling activities experienced by the work force.
- There would be less heavy traffic as a result of the silo one lorry delivery a fortnight with the silo, whereas they currently have two a week.
- The planning committee feels that installation of the silo would make a marked improvement to the current mode of operation of an existing industrial enterprise, with significant environmental gains.
